- 2020 W-2 forms and other records of income earned last year.
- Current bank statements and investment records.
- Records of untaxed income received last year (e.g., TANF, child support received, etc.)
- FSA ID & Password; Both parent and student need an FSA ID & Password. Go to [www.fsaaid.ed.gov](http://www.fsaaid.ed.gov) to set it up.
